

BY-LAW NUMBER 2008-035

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 70-09, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE, GOVERN AND CONTROL THE SALE AND SETTING OFF OF FIREWORKS

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Uxbridge enacted By-law No. 70-09 pursuant to the authority given under the Municipal Act respecting the regulation, governing and control of the sale and setting off of fireworks;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 70-09 in order to more effectively enforce the penalty provisions of said by-law;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** By-law No. 70-09 for the regulation, governance and control of the sale and setting off of fireworks is hereby amended by deleting Sections 5 and 6 and the new Section 5 be added as follows:

“5. Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty for each offence, exclusive of costs, as prescribed by the Provincial Offences Act.”

2. **THAT** this amending by-law shall come into force and effect upon passing.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and finally passed this 31st day of March, 2008.
