

Signs

1. Can I advertise my event with signs in the Township of Uxbridge?

- The Township ONLY permits advertisements for non-profit, registered charity events

2. Where can I put up the signs?

- Signs may be erected on Durham Road 8, and Concession 6. Please contact the By-Law Department to utilize the intersection of Toronto St South and Welwood Drive.

3. When can I put up the signs?

- For a non-profit registered charity, signs may be erected 4 weeks (28 days) prior to the date of the event.

4. When do the signs need to be removed?

- Signs must be removed within 72 hours following the event.

5. What if the event is not a charity? Can I still advertise?

- No. You must request permission from Council for an exemption to the By-Law.

6. Do the same rules apply for Regional Roads?

- No. Regional Roads have a separate by law. Signs on a Regional Road may be erected for no more than 72 hours (3 days) in one place. The signs must be removed or relocated 500 metres from the original location within 72 hours or the Township will remove them.

PLEASE NOTE:

Section 4 of the Township of Uxbridge Sign By-law 2002-059 prohibits any signs painted on, attached to, or supported by a tree, stone, or other natural object, or utility pole, on public property, on a public right-of way, median, traffic island or advertising signs not related to any business located on the lot.
