EXCESS PERMITS

BY-LAW NO. 76-42

TO LOAN ON

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE

WHEREAS Section 352, Chapter 284 of the Municipal Act RSO 1972 and amendments provides that the Councils of all Municipalities may pass by-laws for prohibiting the obstruction of any drain or water course, and for permitting and regulating the size and the type of course situated on a public highway;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to regulate the installation of entranceways over ditches and water courses upon any public highway which forms part of the Township of Uxbridge Road System;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED and it is hereby enacted as a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge as follows:

1. All persons requiring an entrance or driveway to their property from a Township road are required to obtain a permit from the office of the Township Road Superintendent.
2. The diameter, gauge, length and type of culvert to be used shall be determined by the Township Road Superintendent.
3. The location of the entrance way must be approved by the Township Road Superintendent, having in mind sight distance along the road, the location of trees, and other pertinent details.
4. The construction of all entranceways shall be carried out by the Township of Uxbridge under direction of the Township Road Superintendent. Notwithstanding the foregoing regulation the Road Superintendent may authorize and approve an owner or a contractor to install an entranceway, provided the owner or contractor obtains an entranceway permit at a cost of \$25.00 to cover the cost of the inspection.
5. The culvert required for an entranceway cannot be less than 15" in diameter and 20' 0" in length. If the culvert required is greater than 18" in diameter and 24' 0" in length or is located where more than the usual amount of fill is required, the owner shall remit to the Township of Uxbridge, in advance an amount as determined by the Township Road Superintendent to cover the Township's additional material and work involved.
6. A permit will not be issued, nor work commenced until the owner pays in advance the sum of \$300.00 which is the minimum charge of any entranceway, except where a new entranceway does not require a culvert at the present time and will not require a culvert in the future. An entranceway permit will be issued upon advance payment of \$25.00 which is the cost for inspection of the location of the entranceway.
7. When a culvert in excess of 50' 0" in length is requested, the applicant shall be required to pay the entire cost of constructing as many catch basins as may be necessary in the opinion of the Township Road Superintendent, to facilitate surface drainage from the roadway.
8. The tiling and covering of a roadside ditch for the improvement as a front lawn or for any purpose, shall be considered for the purpose the the by-law as an entranceway and shall not be undertaken until a permit is issued.
9. Culverts installed without authorization after the effective date of this by-law shall, after 30 days written notice, be removed by Township forces.
10. No person shall apply an asphalt or concrete surface to that portion of a driveway on the road allowance of a Township road until a permit has been issued by the Township Road Superintendent. No charge is made for permits to pave entranceways and the work shall be carried out by a contractor approved by the Township and in accordance with Township specifications at the expense of the owner.

11. If the owner neglects or refuses to comply with any of the provisions of the by-law, the Township shall remove the obstruction and install a proper entranceway and any expense incurred in so doing shall be recovered from the owner by appropriate actions.
12. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$500.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs recoverable under the Summary Convictions Act.
13. The Township of Uxbridge shall maintain and replace from time to time as required, all culverts installed meeting the requirements of this by-law. The maintenance of the driving surface of the driveway is the responsibility of the owner.
