CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE
BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING
OF CERTAIN ANIMALS.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE HEREBY ENACTS
A BY-LAW AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Subsection 210(1), of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, provide that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities for prohibiting or regulating the keeping of animals or any class thereof within the municipality or defined areas thereof;

AND WHEREAS, Section 321 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of all municipalities for providing that any person who contravenes any by-law of the Council passed under the authority of the said act is guilty of an offence and for providing for the imposition of fines of not more than \$2,000.00 on every person who is convicted of an offence under any such by-law.

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge considers it appropriate to pass a by-law to prohibit the keeping of certain animals;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge enacts a by-law as follows:

DEFINITIONS

1. In this by-law,
 - (a) "animal" includes birds and reptiles.
 - (b) "keep" means own, harbour or have the temporary or permanent possession of an animal, and "kept" has a corresponding meaning;
 - (c) "Township" means the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge.

KEEPING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS

2. (1) No person shall keep or permit to be kept, anywhere in the Township, an animal of a class set out in Schedule "A", attached to and forming part of this by-law.

PENALTIES

3. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence, and upon conviction thereof is liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, exclusive of costs, recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O., 1980, c.400 as amended.

SHORT TITLE


4. This by-law may be referred to as the Exotic Animal Control By-law.

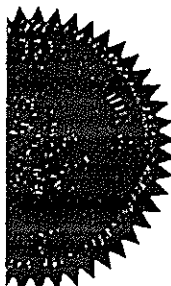
EFFECTIVE DATE

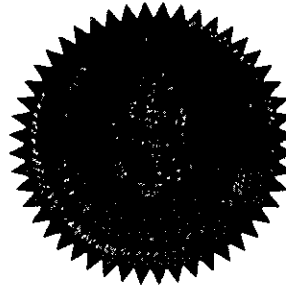

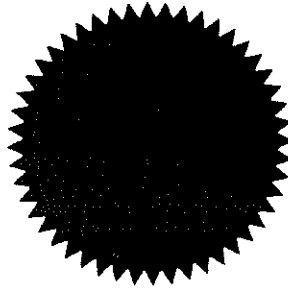
**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 90-9, AS
