BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT AND  
REGULATE THE DISCHARGE OF GUNS  
OR OTHER FIRE-ARMS, AIR-GUNS,  
SPRING-GUNS, CROSS-BOWS,  
LONG-BOWS OR ANY CLASS OR TYPE  
THEREOF IN THE CORPORATION OF  
THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE.

WHEREAS Section 210(29) of the Municipal Act gives Municipal Council the authority to pass by-laws prohibiting and regulating the discharge of guns, etc.;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge hereby ENACTS a By-law as follows:

1. In this By-law:
  - 1.1 "Conservation Officer" means a Conservation Officer or Deputy Conservation Officer appointed pursuant to the Game and Fish Act;
  - 1.2 "Council" means the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge;
  - 1.3 "Defined Areas" include all lands designated in Schedule "A";
  - 1.4 "Fire arms" means every kind, class and type of guns, air-guns, spring-guns, cross-bows and long-bows;
  - 1.5 "Canine Control Officer" means a person appointed by the Township of Uxbridge as Canine Control Officer or an employee of such person;
  - 1.6 "Peace Officer" means a member of a police force or the Canadian Armed Forces.
2. A person shall not discharge any fire-arm within the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge, except in accordance with the following provisions:
  - 2.1 Within the "Defined Areas" no person shall discharge a fire-arm except:
    - (i) a Peace Officer;
    - (ii) a Canine Control Officer in the course of his or her duties;
    - (iii) a Conservation Officer in the course of his or her duties.
  - 2.2 In all other areas of the Township of Uxbridge, outside of the "Defined Areas", no person shall discharge a fire-arm except:
    - (i) a Peace Officer;
    - (ii) a Canine Control Officer in the course of his or her duties;
    - (iii) a Conservation Officer in the course of his or her duties;
    - (iv) a land owner, or tenant authorized by the land owner, upon lands owned and occupied by him or her may discharge a shotgun, or a rifle of no greater calibre than .275, for the control of birds, pests or animals injurious to his or her crops or property, provided that no shot or bullet shall pass over the boundary of the said lands;
    - (v) a hunter having in his or her possession all necessary licences, required by the laws of the Province of Ontario and the Dominion of Canada, to permit the hunter to hunt and to carry and discharge a fire-arm, may discharge a shotgun, or a rifle of no greater calibre than .275, upon a landowner's land provided the hunter has the landowner's consent;

2.2 Continued

(vi) A skeet and trap shooting club, for private members and their guests only, shall only be permitted on these lands described as comprising the east half of Lot 24, Concession III, in the former Township of Uxbridge, provided the following regulations are complied with:

i. during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November in any calendar year, the days and hours of shooting shall only be:

- Saturdays - 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Sundays - 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Wednesdays - 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

ii. during the months of Januray, February, March and December, in any calendar year, the days and hours of shooting shall only be:

- Saturdays - 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Sundays - 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

iii. Council may by Resolution thereof approve additional days and hours for practice sessions, club competitions and open competitions upon application from the club in writing to the Township Clerk for such additional days or hours.

iv. shotguns only shall be fired.

(vi) A private hunt club for members only, shall only be permitted on those lands located in part of Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12, Concession II, in the former Township of Uxbridge, provided firearms are discharged on the lands only between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in any day.

(vii) Upon written application to the Township Clerk, the Council may approve, by Resolution thereof, special firearm competitions and may attach such conditions thereto as Council may deem appropriate and necessary.

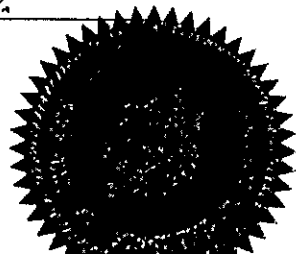
3. Any person discharging a firearm in contravention of the provisions of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall forfeit and pay a penalty of up to \$2,000.00, exclusive of costs, recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.

4. THAT By-law No. 1311, previously enacted by the Council of the former Town of Uxbridge, on the 12th day of July, 1960, is hereby rescinded.

THIS BY-LAW GIVEN ITS FIRST, SECOND and THIRD READINGS and finally passed on the 27th day of November , 1989.

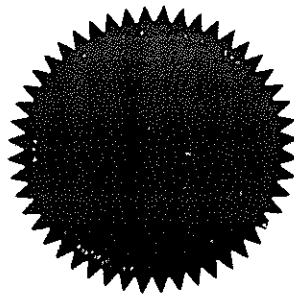

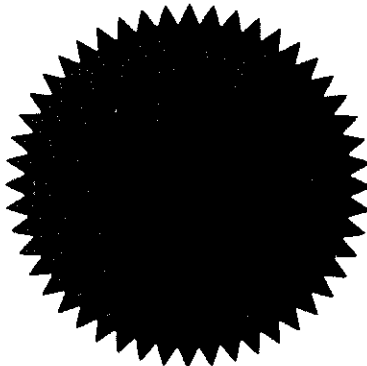

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and finally passed this 24th day of September, 2001.

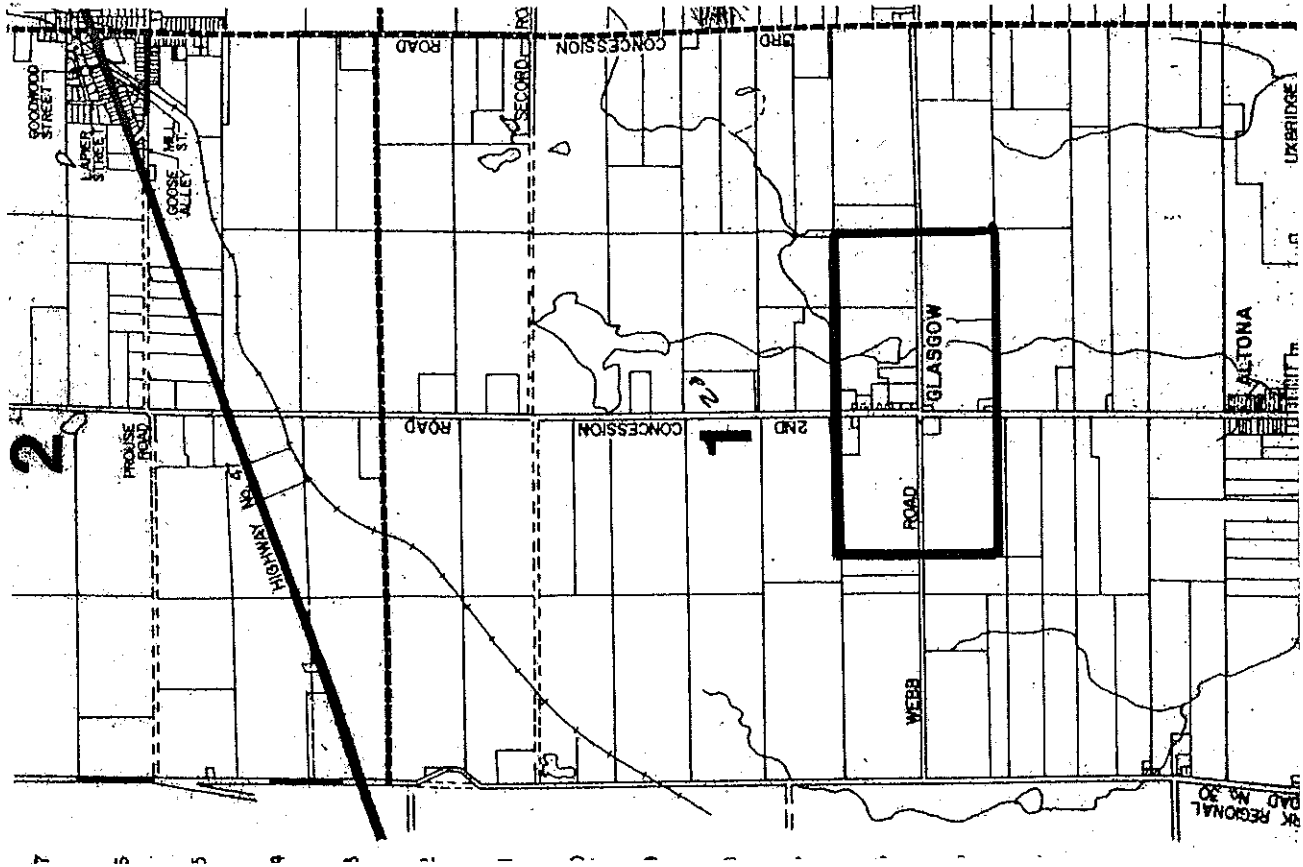
