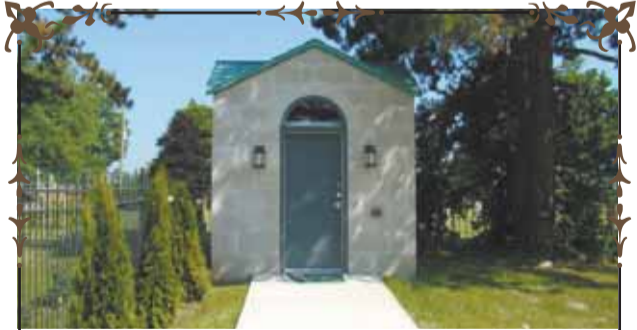
### What's new...

#### Leaskdale Manse



We are pleased to announce that with the assistance of Parks Canada, the Township of Uxbridge and the Lucy Maud Montgomery Society of Ontario (LMMSO) committee the interior of the Leaskdale Manse will be restored to the time of Lucy Maud Montgomery's residency (1917). For the first time, you will be able to see the window that Lucy Maud looked out of while writing her books and see the hidden back staircase that her boys would sneak down to steal cookies. The official opening will be announced.

Wheelchair Accessible Washroom at Foster

"The Diamond of Durham", is listed as one of the top 100 "Unusual Things to see in Ontario". This grand facility is now fully accessible and has a new washroom facility thanks to a grant from Human Resources & Social Development Canada (Enabling Accessibility Fund Program), the Township of Uxbridge and the Foster Committee. The new washroom is built in the image of the Thomas Foster Memorial and completes this site to facilitate weddings, concerts, funerals, and festivals.

#### Historical Centre



Come to the Centre to learn about the history of Uxbridge Township. With the completion of the accessibility ramps last year, all of our buildings are now 100% accessible. Along with a great view of the Uxbridge valley, beautiful grounds, picnic tables and indoor facilities, the Centre now has horseshoe pitches and giant games for family fun.
